# COMPONENT 1 – SECTION 1 (20<sup>TH</sup> C. LIT)

## SURVIVE!

Focus on individual words and try to refer to the writer's craft.

When comparing, just compare the basics.

Use only the lines numbers as directed.

## THRIVE!

Start with an overview sentence where you can.

When comparing, go into subtleties of the writer's craft.

# COMPONENT 1 – SECTION 2 (CREATIVE PROSE)

## SURVIVE!

Use a maximum of 3 characters.

Write from experience, one way or another.

Avoid: zombies, football, vampires, soldiers, etc. And dialogue!

Use basic punctuation correctly.

## THRIVE!

Use dialogue to accelerate plot or character.

Have a message/theme in your story.

# COMPONENT 2 — SECTION 1 (19<sup>TH</sup>/20<sup>TH</sup> C. NON-F)

## SURVIVE!

Focus on individual words and try to refer to the writer's entire argument.

When comparing, just compare the basics.

## THRIVE!

Start with an overview sentence where you can.

When comparing, go into subtleties of the arguments presented.

# COMPONENT 2 — SECTION 2 (TRANSACTIONAL)

## SURVIVE!

Use the paragraph formula.

Suggest 3 developed ideas/solutions/concepts per piece.

## THRIVE!

Use a variety of devices and punctuation.

Suggest more than 3 developed ideas.
